

Privacy Policy and Use of Personal Information

Canopy Privacy Policy and Agreement

Canopy understands that your privacy is important to you. That's why it's important to us to ensure that we're providing you best-in-class services with best-in-class protection. This Privacy Policy and Agreement ("Privacy Policy") is designed to inform you of what information we collect about you and how we use it. Article 1

Information Collected About You

Information that can be used to identify or contact you is known as Personally Identifiable Information (Personal Information). When you visit this site, we collect only the Personal Information that you provide to us. This information is collected when you register for login access.

Site Registration

As part of the registration process participants are asked to provide information including name, date of birth, gender, and ethnicity. These pieces of information are optional. If you choose not to provide this information you are still able to use the App effectively. Providing this information helps to provide the most clinically relevant solution to the participant.

Children

We are committed to protecting the privacy of children. This website is not designed or intended to attract children under the age of 13. Personal Information about anyone actually known to be under the age of 13 is not collected.

Article 2

Disclosure of Your Information

Except as stated below or as specifically agreed to by you, Canopy will not disclose the Personal Information it gathers from you on this website. We may release Personal Information to third parties: (1) in compliance with legal requirements such as law, regulation, search warrant, subpoena or court order; or (2) in special cases, such as the threat of physical violence against you or others. In any case where we are legally compelled to reveal your Personal Information, we will notify you at once, unless doing so would violate the law or court order.

Disclosure to Canopy Operations and Maintenance Contractors

Canopy operations and maintenance contractors sometimes have limited access to your Personal Information in the course of providing products and services to Canopy. These contractors include vendors and suppliers that provide us with technology, services and content related to better operation and maintenance of our website. Access by these contractors is limited to the information reasonably necessary in order for the contractor to perform its limited function for Canopy. We also contractually require that our operations and maintenance contractors (1) protect the privacy of your Personal Information in a manner consistent with this Privacy Policy, and (2) not use or disclose your Personal Information for any purpose other than providing us with products and services.

Article 3

Policies for Managing Personal Information

Canopy takes reasonable measures to protect information about you from loss, theft, misuse and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction. Canopy uses secure servers to protect all data collected from participants through the Program. When you access or use the Canopy website it automatically collects information about you, including login information, device information, and your mobile phone operating system.

By registering for the Program, you agree to accept all the risks of unauthorized access to your data, and any other information you provide to Canopy and/or the Program.

You can always contact us in order to delete your Personal Information from our systems by accessing the "Delete Account Form", however by doing so you will no longer be granted access to the website.

You should be aware that it is not technologically possible to remove each and every record of the information you have provided to Canopy from our servers. The need to back-up our systems to protect information from inadvertent loss means that a copy of your Personal Information may exist in a non-erasable form that will be difficult or impossible for us to locate. Nevertheless, we promise that upon receiving your request, all Personal Information stored in the databases we actively use for research and daily business activities, and other readily searchable media, will be deleted.
